The Requirements for On-The-Job Training

1. Certification:

Applicants must be certified plumbers or have at least 5 years continuous working experience.

2. Educational Qualification:

Recent graduates with Level 2 and/or 3 plumbing knowledge from a trade school or relevant program are eligible.

3. Proof of Certification or Education:

Applicants need to provide documentation of their certification or graduation from a recognized program.

4. Application Form:

Applicants must complete our company's official application form. (Please attach the link to the form provided

5. Resume:

A current resume highlighting their plumbing education, skills, and any relevant experience.

6. Interview:

A brief interview to assess their knowledge, attitude, and suitability for the program.

Police Record:

A recent police record

7. Proof of identification:

- ✓ A copy of Government ID or an updated driver's license
- ✓ TRN
- ✓ 2 Passport Size Photo one sign by a JP
- ✓ 2 Recent recommendation.

8. Basic Tools:

Trainees must have their own basic plumbing tools.

9. Commitment:

Trainee is required to sign a confidentiality agreement to complete the training and adhere to company policies.
